ATTENTION GREENWICH TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

THE FOLLOWING IS LATEST INFORMATION ON THE COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

All residents wanting to receive the vaccination, you MUST register at the following website:
covidvaccine.nj.gov (State Dept. of Health Registration Site)

Once registered you will be contacted by the state (with the information you provide) when your phase is eligible to schedule your vaccination

There will be a Mega Vaccination Site located at Rowan College of South Jersey and smaller locations at select Shop Rites

The Phases for vaccinations, as determined by the State Dept. of Health are as follows:

Phase 1A: Healthcare Workers = Hospital Staff to include Doctors, Nurses, and those personnel/staff who would have direct contact with a positive or suspected positive COVID patient. Also includes Paramedics and EMTs who again, are at constant risk of being exposed to a COVID positive patient/transporting same to a hospital setting and Residents and Staff of Long Term Congregate Care facilities. (Occurring now around the state)

Phase 1B: First Responders/Essential Personnel = Frontline Essential Workers (Fire, Police, and OEM) and individuals over 75 years of age. (Estimated to begin mid to late January)

Phase 1C: include other essential workers, adults 65-74, and persons aged 16-64 with medical conditions that increase the risk for severe COVID-19. (Estimated to begin in February)

Phase 2: The General Population (Estimated to begin in March)

As per the State Health Dept., "The timing of the progression among the groups depends on the supply of vaccine to the state balanced by the demand in various phases".
