

Keep an eye out for deer when driving.
The deer rut season will be upon us shortly.

If you do need deer carcass removal, residents can contact the Gloucester County Highway Division to have deer carcasses removed from county and municipal roadways. Deer carcasses will be removed within 48 hours of time reported. Deer carcasses will be removed from the right-of-way on all county and municipal roadways not state highways. NJDOT removes the carcasses on state highways

To report a deer carcass, contact (856) 307-6400 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday through Friday. All other hours and weekends contact (856) 589-0911. ***Deer carcasses will not be removed from private property.*** For state highway removal, call 609-588-6213.

Please note: The Gloucester County Highway Department ***does not*** pick up other deceased animals on the roadways. This notice is referring solely to deer.

Remember: deer often travel in herds. If you see one deer cross a roadway, use caution because more than often there will be more following - sometimes with several seconds between them.
